WHO CAN QUALIFY?

- School-Aged children in San Diego County
- Eligibility is based on monthly income, family size, and childcare need.
- Families who are eligible for state childcare support through childcaresandiego.com

HOW MUCH SUPPORT CAN I QUALIFY FOR?

- Our scholarship amount will closely align with a state childcare subsidy, amounting to about 90–100% of the program cost and are valid until the end of 2020.

HOW ARE APPLICANTS SELECTED AND HOW ARE THE SCHOLARSHIP USED?

- Scholarships are given on a first-come, first-served basis for YMCA child care programs at branches and school sites!
